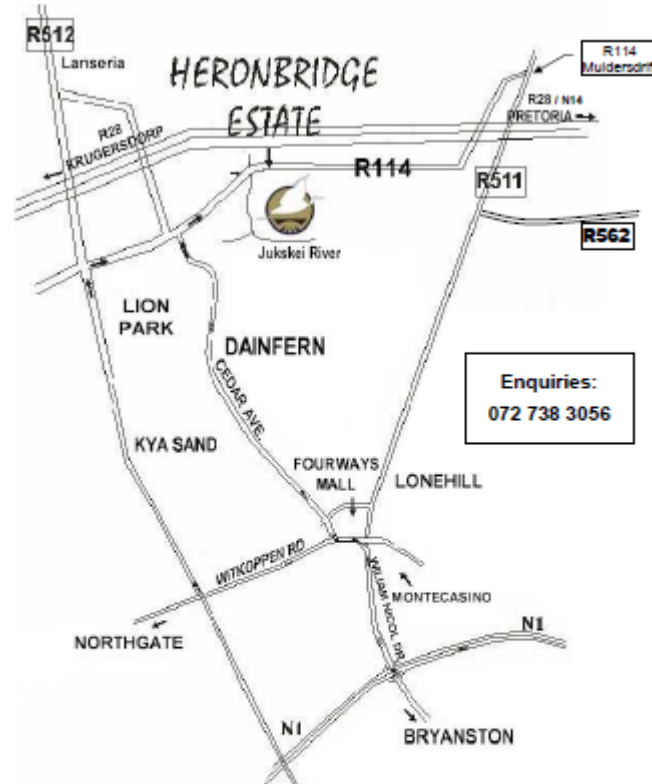

FROM THE SOUTH:	FROM THE NORTH:
<p>From the "concrete highway" (N1/N3) take the William Nicol/Fourways off-ramp, and travel out to Fourways. At the Montecasino corner take the sliproad left into Witkoppen Dr. Turn right at the first robot (Cedar Road.) Travel for approx. 8kms. At the T-junction, turn right (sign says Pretoria). After 2 kms, cross the river, and turn right into the Heronbridge gate.</p>	<p>From the R28/N14 (Pretoria/Krugersdorp highway) take the R512 (Lanseria Airport) off-ramp and follow signs to Randburg. At robots (Lion Park Cafe) turn left. Pass the Lion Park on your right, pass Cedar Road and small shopping centre (Lion Park Produce) on your right, cross the river and turn right into the Heronbridge gate.</p>
